Responsibilities:

- Manage expected standard of care which includes obtaining history, assessing, diagnosing, and developing a plan of care and treatment for our patients.
- Prescribing appropriate medications.
- Counsel and educate patients on preventative care options
- Perform and execute other appropriate patient care under the scope of Urgent Care which includes, but is not limited to, laceration repair, X-ray interpretation, EKG interpretation and wellness examinations.
- DOT certified. If not current, anticipate obtaining within 3 months of employment.

- Experience with electronic medical records
- Organizational and analytical skills necessary to maintain efficient workflow

- Knowledge of basic ER, internal medicine, generalist, occupational medicine, and family practice procedures
- Ability to repair lacerations
- Ability to use the necessary equipment such as nebulizer and EKG machine
- Must be able to use manual dexterity in relation to clinical requirements and able to lift 50 lbs.
